**HOW TO REGISTER:**

1. Complete a separate registration form for each student.
2. Staple your check, made payable to **CEF**, to the registration form. No cash will be accepted. Use **one check per class** and note the **class name and your child's first and last name in the memo section of the check**.
3. There is a \$30.00 registration fee for students who are not enrolled as Carlsbad Unified School District students or are not Carlsbad residents. This fee is to cover immunization records and administrative fees. Please add this to your total at time of registration.
4. Staple your check to the **signed and fully completed registration form** and mail to CEF at 5651 Palmer Way, Suite H, Carlsbad, CA 92010 or you may drop it off at our office no later than **May 28, 2010. Classes are filled as registration forms and full payment is received, first come, first served.** Any registration form received after May 28 will be date stamped and students will be placed in summer classes only if space allows.
5. Please write down or make a copy of your child's registration form so that you can refer to it for the dates, times, location, and classes you have signed your child up for this summer.
6. You will **NOT** be notified that your student has been enrolled in a class. We will contact you **ONLY** if there is a cancellation or change in times for a class you signed up for.
7. **There will be no registration at the district office or at Jefferson Elementary the day the summer enrichment programs start.**

Priority enrollment will be given to students who attend and reside in the Carlsbad Unified School District. Please note that classes will be filled on a first come, first served basis. All classes have enrollment maximums. Classes fill quickly, so get your registration form and check in as soon as possible. Classes are filled as registration forms and checks arrive. Course content may change to meet the needs of the students and/or the availability of teachers.

Students not attending a Carlsbad school during the 2009-10 school year must provide **proof of immunization**. This may be done by either attaching a copy of proof of immunization or attaching a note indicating that proof is on file at a specific school along with the school's phone number or address. We will contact the school for immunization compliance.

**REFUNDS:**

There will be no refunds after May 28, 2010. Refunds prior to May 28 are subject to a non-refundable program fee of \$35.00 and may take up to eight weeks to process.

**CLASS CANCELLATION:**

We do our best to accommodate all students who sign up for the summer enrichment programs. To keep fees as low as possible, a minimum enrollment for each class is set to cover expenses. If the minimum enrollment is not met, a class may be cancelled. Courses may need to be changed to a different time if a class does not fill to minimum enrollment or an instructor conflict arises around scheduling. If these occur, you will be contacted and you will have the opportunity to sign up for an open class or receive a full refund.

**AGE RANGES:**

To develop classes suitable for a particular age and academic range, we specify ages in the class description. When enrollments are large enough, students may be grouped into smaller age-ranges to better facilitate learning.

**FULL-DAY CHILDCARE:**

This year's Summer Enrichment Program will be co-located with our full-day Summer Kids' Care program, a State-licensed childcare program providing structured activities, enrichment, and fun every day between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6:25 p.m. If you would like to enroll your child in Kids' Care for times before or after his or her Summer Enrichment course, please complete the appropriate questions on the registration form. Half-day care provided through Kids' Care costs \$20 per day or \$85 for the entire week. Combining our programs affords a great opportunity for kids and working parents!

**SIBLING AND MULTIPLE CLASS DISCOUNTS:**

If you enroll two or more children from the same family in our programs, your second and subsequent children will receive 10% off the regular tuition cost for any summer enrichment or combined Kids' Care/summer enrichment program. Additionally, if your child enrolls in multiple programs during the four-week period, you will receive 10% off the regular tuition cost of their second and any subsequent programs. *Please note: These discounts cannot be combined, so 10% off is the maximum discount available for any program.*
